This is an outline/timeline for completion of the required science fair project in **Honor's Science 2016/2017 (optional for all other Middle School Students)**. **Individual projects only.** This timeline is a tool for both you and your student to ensure major sections of the project are completed in an orderly and timely fashion. Please encourage students to not wait until the last minute to prepare their projects. While some class time will be dedicated to the development of certain aspects of the program, students will need to conduct the investigation and data collection portion of the project at home or at an approved research facility. Assistance from parents and other adults is encouraged, however, the idea for the project should be the student's in order for them to be excited and invested in the work involved.

As you can see from the timeline, the project will be counted **for a total of 6 daily grades and 3 major test grades**. Failure to complete the project will have a profound impact on the student's class average. Please keep a daily Science Journal (include dates)
